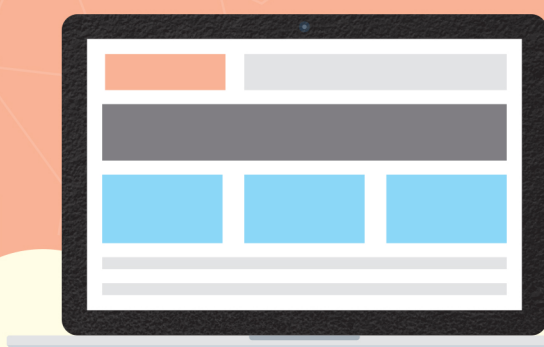


Here are some eye-opening stats on why creating a **Workplace Community** is so important.

5. Attract and retain the best talent **43%**

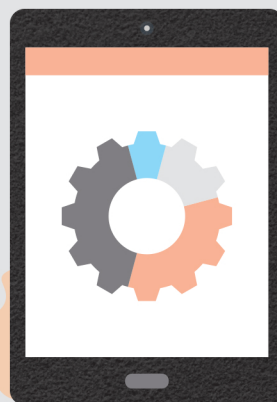


The new generation of workers are serious collaborators.
